Dear Ms MacWood:

I am writing to request that a red light camera be put at the intersection of Connecticut Avenue and Ordway Streets, NW.

Yesterday, at about 2:30pm, I saw three cars blatantly run the red light. (Two southbound; one heading north.)

It's almost a certainty that some car will run a red light during any given light cycle.

Connecticut and Ordway is an important—and often dangerous—pedestrian intersection. Right around this intersection is a movie theater, supermarket, post office, many restaurants, and other destinations frequented by pedestrians.

I think that a red light camera at Connecticut and Ordway would go a long way toward making Connecticut Avenue safer to cross, and I urge you to do what you can to get a red light camera installed there as soon as possible.
